

ORDINANCE NO. 205

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HOUSTON, MINNESOTA  
ESTABLISHING RULES AND REGULATIONS  
FOR OPERATION OF THE CITY TREE BURN SITE  
IN THE CITY OF HOUSTON, MINNESOTA

The City Council of the City of Houston does ordain:

Section 1. The City of Houston has established a tree burn disposal site for the benefit of its citizens. This burn site is to be used solely by residents of the City of Houston. City taxpayers solely fund the site lease and disposal expenses related to the burn site.


Section 2. Items allowed to be disposed of at the tree burn site include brush, trees and parts thereof including branches and trunks. No other items are allowed to be disposed of at the tree burn site including but not limited to boards, stumps, garbage, grass clippings, and leaves.

Section 3. City residents may drop off items allowed in section 2 on Saturday only at the manned site during established hours of operation of the Houston County Drop-Off Site adjacent to the City of Houston burn site.


Section 4. A fee schedule will be adopted and updated from time to time as changes are warranted (see attachment 1). Fees will be collected on site by the burn site supervisor.

Section 5. Any person violating the conditions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a petty misdemeanor and shall be subject to the fines thereof.
